The Energize Colleges Program (www.energizecolleges.org) is a partnership between College of Marin and Strategic Energy Innovations to develop student knowledge, skill and experience within energy career pathways. Internships are 8-10 hours per week at \$13 per hour.

The Golden Gate Electric Vehicle Association (<http://www.ggeva.org/>) an all-volunteer, educational, support, and advocacy non-profit organization that promotes electric vehicles (EVs). GGEVA is a chapter of the Electric Auto Association, with primary activities Marin County and San Francisco. Interns are expected to promote electric vehicles and charging management through presentations, coordinate related energy, education, workforce development programs, and attend weekly campus team meetings.

The position starts immediately through Spring Semester 2017 and will run for approximately one academic term, potentially through Summer 2017.

APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a currently enrolled COM student, pursuing an environmental degree or related field, such as engineering, business, social science, technical or vocational trades, and have completed 1-2 courses in their major
- Have an interest in learning about, researching, and advocating for EVs, the benefits of EV charging, and electric grid management
- Attend weekly campus team meetings at Kentfield Campus
- Participate in energy education high school engagement project
- Enroll in an internship course during Spring Semester (may be waived)
- Have a driver's license and transportation to travel to meetings and events
- Possess excellent written and presentation skills
- Have confidence working across Microsoft Office (MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc.)
- Be reliable and dependable with excellent time management skills
- Have teamwork experience

DUTIES AND EXPECTATIONS:

- Develop a presentation(s) on the benefits of EVs for a gasoline or diesel driver audience
- Present to civic organizations and groups such as Lions Clubs, religious organizations, environmental groups, companies, etc. Some presentations may require evening and weekend hours. Conduct surveys to measure audience response to presentations

- Will acquire an in-depth knowledge of all aspects of EVs and charging
- Will understand how EV charging management can benefit the electrical grid
- Will gain experience in speaking to groups and delivering presentations
- Will gain experience in measuring the impact of presentations
