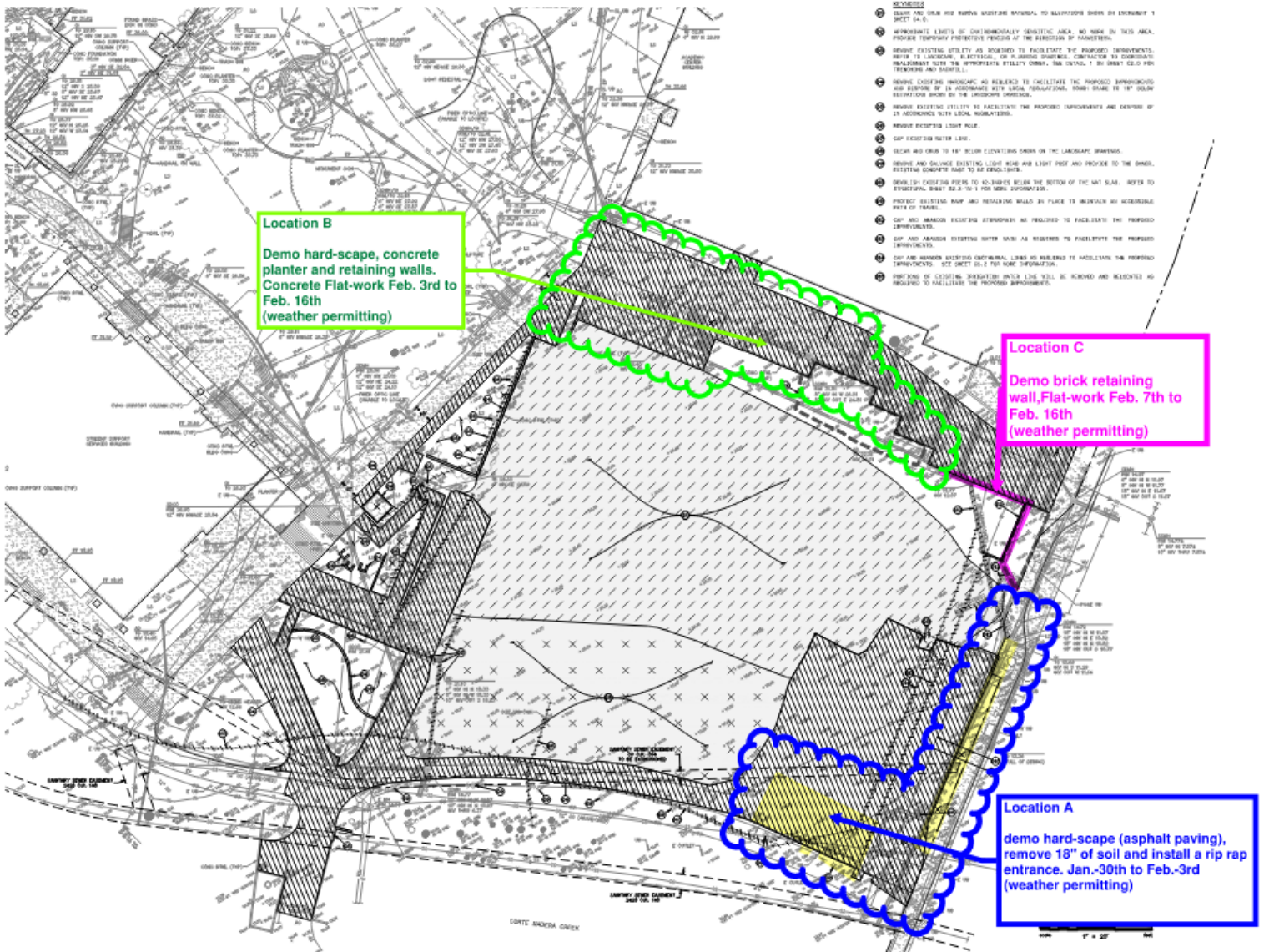
Notice of Construction Activities 01.30.2023 – 2.03.23

Beginning **Monday, January 30th**, increment one construction will begin at the site of the new LRC. As a reminder, increment one involves demolition of the last remaining elements of the old LRC including retaining walls and pathways as well as grading, shoring, soil mixing and other various ground improvements.

The following activities will take place over the next week, January 30 – February 3.

1. Installation of sound mitigation blankets/measures on the exterior of the Academic Center
2. Demolition of the asphalt paving at the construction entrance on College Avenue (Location A)

Beginning **February 3**, demolition of the concrete paving and retaining walls will begin by the Academic Center. (Locations B & C)



This will be extremely noisy work to remove the features in this area. You can expect to hear consistent jack hammering over the course of a week. Sound blankets are being installed on the exterior of the Academic Center Building to help mitigate this noise. The contractor will work tirelessly to try to complete this noisy work as quickly as possible, but in order to keep schedule cannot delay the completion of this scope. We understand the inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we get through this very noisy portion.

Noise you will expect to hear onsite:

1. Jack hammering
2. Idling trucks
3. Back up alerts
4. Generic construction noise such as power tools, hammering, etc

*Work is always contingent on weather and resources
