Notice of Construction Activities 02.06.2023 – 2.12.23

Increment one construction is underway at the site of the new LRC. As a reminder, increment one involves demolition of the last remaining elements of the old LRC including retaining walls and pathways as well as grading, shoring, soil mixing and other various ground improvements.

The following activities will take place over the next week, **February 6 – February 12.**

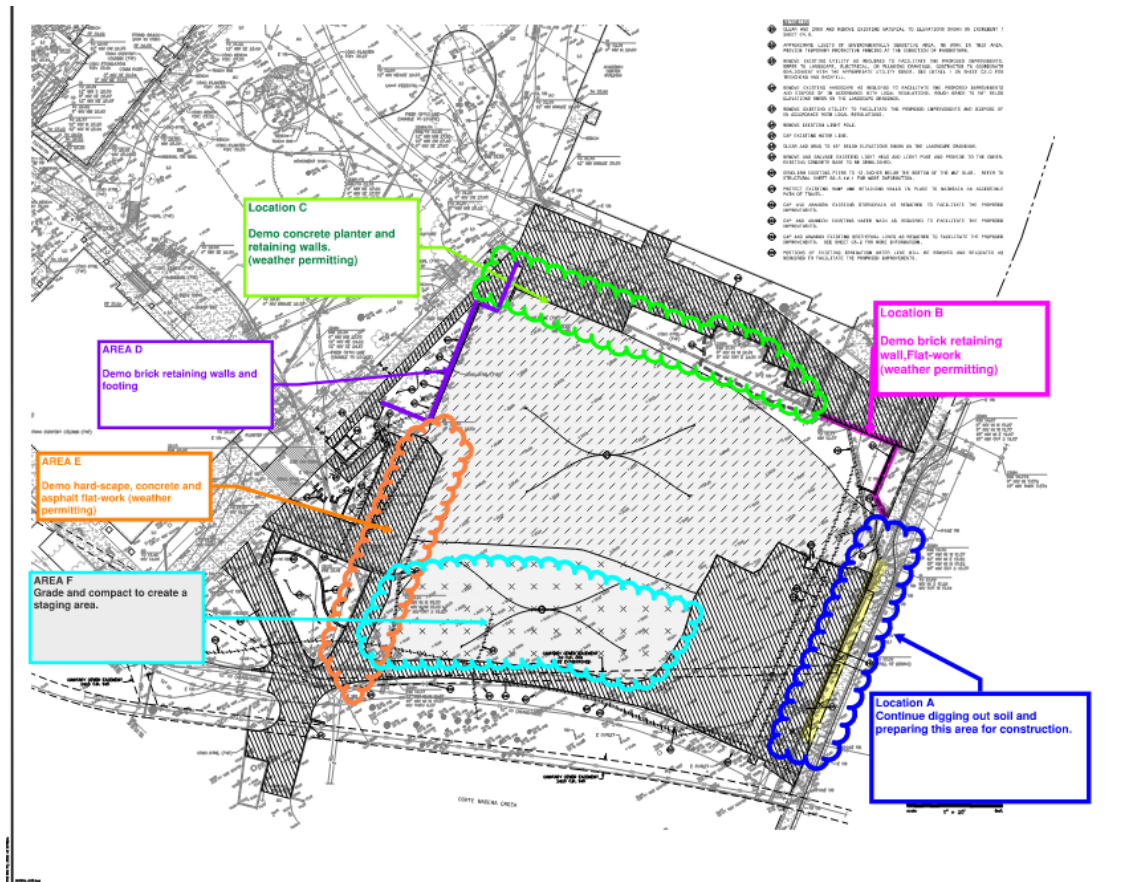
1. Digging out and preparing the area at the construction entrance on College Avenue (Location A)
2. Digging out and preparing the area on the site that will be used as staging (Location F)

Demolition of concrete paving and retaining walls has begun. (See areas B, C, D, and E on the map below.)

This is very noisy work. You can expect to hear consistent jack hammering and debris being loaded onto trucks. Sound blankets have been installed on the exterior of the Academic Center Building to help mitigate this noise. The contractor will work tirelessly to try to complete this noisy work as quickly as possible, but in order to keep schedule cannot delay the completion of this scope. We understand the inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we get through this very noisy portion.

Noise you will expect to hear onsite:

1. Jack hammering
2. Idling trucks
3. Back up alerts
4. Generic construction noise such as power tools, hammering, etc
